











Factories Corporation of Jamaica Limited was on display at the World Free Zone Organisation, Annual International Conference and Exhibition (AICE) in Montego Bay, St. James.

The global event, a first to be held in Jamaica, brought approximately 1500 attendees to the Montego Bay Convention Centre in Montego Bay, St. James. It was held from June 13-17, 2022.

World class speakers, senior policy makers, global business leaders from multilateral organisations and representatives from international free zones came together to share best practices and foster public awareness of free zones and the opportunities they create for economic growth.
