The 148,000 sq. ft. complex will replace the former Boundbrook Industrial Estate and serve as a comprehensive commercial hub offering services from both the public and private sectors. It will house, among others, the Portland Municipal Corporation, Tax Administration of Jamaica, Business Process Outsourcing (BPO) companies and dining options.

Construction is expected to span over 24 months.
